ValPar.CH – Values of the ecological infrastructure in Swiss parks is an interdisciplinary research project:

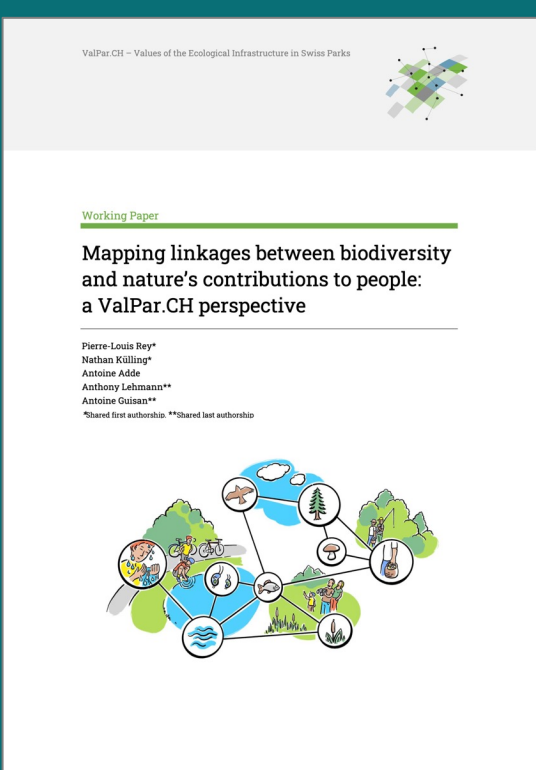
- Researchers from five universities analyse the social, economic and ecological values of nature.
- It is commissioned by the Swiss Federal Office for the Environment (FOEN) as part of a pilot project of the 'Action Plan for the Swiss Biodiversity Strategy'.

The goals of the **ValPar.CH Working Paper Series** are:

- 1) develop a common understanding on crucial concepts and methods for researchers, funders, and other relevant stakeholders;
- 2) provide a platform for quick publication of papers from the partnership.

The regular and direct exchange with different groups of stakeholders (i.e. cantonal authorities, parks of national importance, NGOs) is integral part of ValPar.CH.

Each working paper is reviewed by team colleagues, designed uniformly (incl. graphics/illustrations), receives a DOI and an ISSN and is openly available on both UZH ZORA and the ValPar.CH website (www.valpar.ch).



The **ValPar.CH Working Paper Series** enables the quick publication of synthesised project knowledge. It addresses (scientifically) interested stakeholders working on related topics, but not necessarily in academia. It thus serves the much needed exchange at the science-policy-practice interface.

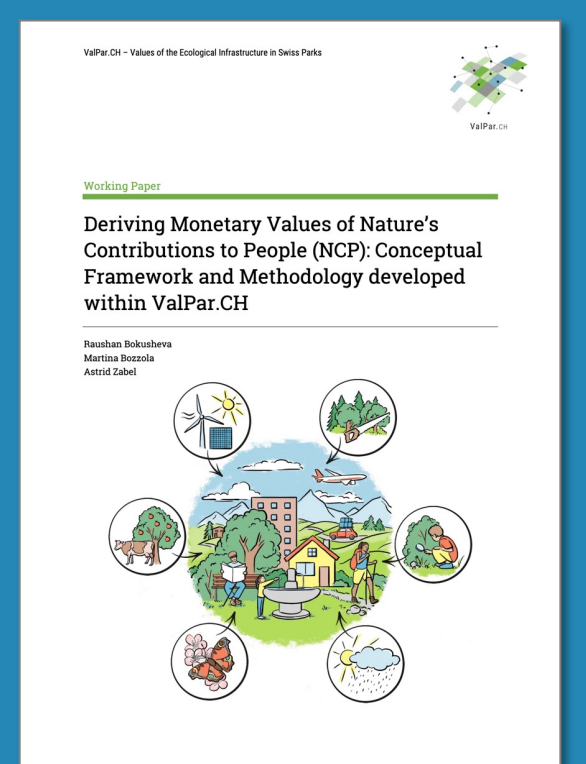
